PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION TO INDIAN SYSTEM OF MEDICINE COURSES 2018-19 SESSION.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:-

1. (a) Candidates seeking admission to ISM courses should submit the **application form** with necessary enclosures should reach:

- (b) The candidates shall ensure that the completed application form with all particulars and enclosures reaches the Consortium within the date and time specified. Applications received by Speed post / Courier or any other means, after the last date & time will not be accepted irrespective of the date of booking.
- (c) The Consortium shall not be responsible for any delay in the receipt or for the loss in transit of application form etc.
- (d) Request for extension of time for submission of documents called for, after the specified date and time will not be entertained.
- (e) Any supporting documents received after the due date or application without required documents / particulars will not be entertained.
- (f) All the demand drafts should be drawn in favour of "TNPPCA-HS" payable at Chennai.
- (g) Photocopy / Fax copy of application will not be accepted.
- (h) Candidates should inform the change of address, immediately to the Consortium. If the change of address is not intimated to the Consortium in time, the Consortium will not be responsible for delay in communication or its consequences.
- 2. The details of the member Institutions of the consortium is given in Annexure I

3. The following courses are offered by Institutions:-

- a. Homoeopathy (B.H.M.S)
- b. Siddha (B.S.M.S)
- c. Ayurveda (B.A.M.S)
- d. Naturopathy and Yogic Sciences (B.N.Y.S)
- 4. Admission will be done as per the Supreme Court and State Government directions.

5. Educational Qualifications

- i. Candidates should have passed in **all the subjects** of the qualifying examination of the Higher Secondary course conducted by the Tamilnadu State Board or any other equivalent Board in the following group of subjects with minimum eligible marks.
 - (a) Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology.

or

- (b) Physics, Chemistry, Biology or Mathematics with any other subject.
- ii. Candidates who have passed any other equivalent examinations with same group of subjects should submit an Eligibility Certificate obtained from the Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University before admission to any institution for the course of their choice.

6. Eligibility

The eligibility criteria for admission to the various courses offered in Institutions shall be as prescribed by the Tamilnadu Dr.M.G.R Medical University.

7. Minimum Eligibility Marks:-

B.S.M.S / B.A.M.S / B.N.Y.S / B.U.M.S & B.H.M.S Courses in respect of all communities.

•Tamilnadu Candidates:

12th Standard with Science or any other equivalent examination recognized by University or Boards with **fifty percent aggregate marks** in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry and Biology or Botany and Zoology taken together.

•Other State Candidates:

Based on marks obtained in NEET UG-2018 conducted by (NBE) National Board of Examinations.

8. Non-Eligibility

BSMS/ BAMS/ BNYS/ BHMS:-

Candidates who have passed HSC in Vocational stream and private candidates or who have passed Pre-University Course or candidates who have passed through open schooling.

9. Age Limit

Candidates should have completed the age of Seventeen years on or before 31st December 2018.Evidence should be produced.

10. Normalization of Marks:

As per the Tamilnadu Act No.3 of 2007, dt 5.3.2007 and G.O (Ms) No.77/HE (J2) Dept. dt.05.04.2007, the marks obtained by the students in the relevant subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by various Boards or Authority shall be equated with the marks obtained by the students in the same subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by the State Board by adopting the method of normalization.

<u>Explanation</u>:- Under the method of normalization the highest mark obtained by the students of various Boards in each subject will be equated to the highest mark obtained by the students of State Board in that subject and the relative marks obtained by other students in that subject will be determined accordingly.

11. Procedure for filling & submission of Application form:

- (a) Before filling up the OMR sheet (Application form), read all the instructions carefully.
- (b) Use one common OMR sheet (Application form) for Indian System of Medicine courses. No candidate should submit more than one application.
- (c) Fill up the OMR sheet legibly, neatly and correctly. The information will be processed by using a computer. Any mistake committed by the candidate will prejudice the selection (Model of the filled in OMR sheet is given in Annexure II).
- (d) Do not fold OMR sheet under any circumstance. Making a hole, using a pin or a stapler on the OMR sheets should be avoided. Cutting, overwriting and erasing in the OMR sheet should be strictly avoided.
- (e) The OMR sheet with incomplete or insufficient particulars or without enclosures or those received after the last date mentioned will be summarily rejected without any intimation to the candidate.
- (f) Filled up OMR sheet without the signature of the candidate will be rejected.
- (g) The Government orders issued and to be issued from time to time pertaining to any of the matters contained in the prospectus should be read as part and parcel of this prospectus and such terms and conditions in the Government Order are deemed to have been incorporated in this prospectus.
- (h) Candidates should affix recent passport size photographs in the OMR sheet. The photograph need not be attested.
- (i) All the entries in the OMR sheet should be written legibly by the candidate in his / her own handwriting. The candidate should ensure that all information including the marks in the qualifying examination furnished by him / her in the OMR sheet and the enclosures are correct.

The candidate is informed that if after proper scrutiny, the marks furnished by him/ her in

the application are not correct or any other information is found to be incorrect, he / she will forfeit the admission no matter at what stage of the course, he / she will be at that time.

12. Submission of Enclosures:

Candidates are instructed to enclose only the **attested photocopies (not original)** of the following certificates along with the OMR sheet:-

- (i) H.S.C mark sheet or any other equivalent examination.
- (ii) Transfer certificate obtained after the completion of H.S.C or equivalent courses.
- (iii) Community Certificate (if applicable).
- (iv) candidates who have submitted mark sheet with GRADES should obtain the Statement of marks indicating the actual marks secured from the examination Authority and attached a certified copy as an enclosure to the application. If not, the minimum marks of the grades alone will be taken in to consideration.
- (v) NEET UG 2018 Hall Ticket & Score Card (If applicable)

13. Method of Selection:

- (i) Ranking will be made on merit on the basis of marks obtained by the eligible candidates in the prescribed science/maths subject in the qualifying examinations reduced to the basis of 200 marks.
- (ii)The marks obtained through different boards will be taken into account after normalization.

14. Method of Admission:

- (a) Admission will be made only on the basis of rank list prepared by the Association.
- (b) The Selected candidates should produce all the original documents at the time of admission.
- (c) All selections and admission are only provisional. The selection is liable to be cancelled at any time as and when the eligibility conditions are found to be defective or incorrect or there has been suppression or misrepresentation of facts.
- (d) Candidates selected for admission are not guaranteed any appointment in Government Service.

15. Merit List:

The result will be published on the website <u>www.tnppcahs.org</u>. After the publication of Merit list, the candidates should contact the respective colleges.

16. Determination of Rank of Candidates obtaining equal marks:

In cases, where two or more candidates obtain equal aggregate marks for 200, the rank of such candidates shall be determined on the basis of the following order, namely:

(a) Percentage in Biology or Botany & Zoology taken together in Higher Secondary Course

examination.

- (b) Percentage in Chemistry in Higher Secondary Course examination.
- (c) Percentage in Fourth optional subject in Higher Secondary Course examination.
- (d) Date of birth weightage given to seniority in age.

17. Duration of the Courses:

As prescribed by the Tamilnadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University for each course mentioned below:-

Course	Duration
BSMS / BAMS / BNYS / BHMS	5 1/2 years of study including one year compulsory Rotatory Resident Internship.

18. Tuition Fees:-

The Tuition fees for the following courses in Self Financing Colleges shall be collected as fixed by the Committee for the fixation of Fee for Private Professional Educational Institutions. Any modification in the fee structure for the academic year 2018 - 19 as fixed by the Fee Fixation Committee will be intimated in due course.

The above fee does not include Hostel, Transport, Mess charges etc. Any modification in the fee for 2018-19 fixed by the Fee Committee will be intimated.

19. Registration Fee:

Registration fee fixed as Rs.400/-. The amount should be sent by an "A/c Payee" Crossed **Demand Draft**. The Demand Draft should be drawn on any Nationalised Bank in favour of "TNPPCA-HS" payable at Chennai".

20. Internet Facility:

Candidates can access our website http://www.tnppcahs.org for all information and can download the Application Form. (Complete details are available in our "INFORMATION BROCHURE") Candidates using the downloaded application form, shall send Rs. 600/- Demand Draft (Application cost Rs.200/- and Registration fee Rs.400/-) along with application form.

21. Strict Instruction:-

As per the instruction of the Chairman, Committee to Regulate/Monitor the Admission, Guindy, Chennai – 600 025, the Institutions should not collect capitation fee in any form from the students, since it is strictly prohibited as per the Supreme Court Judgement.

22. Ragging:-

The Candidates who join the course should not indulge or participate in any kind of ragging throughout their study period. If they are found to have indulged in ragging at any time, the candidate will be removed from the roll of the Institution at whatever stage of study and criminal action will be taken against the candidate.

23. Candidates applied for Indian System of Medicine Courses are deemed to have read the contents in the prospectus and agreed with all conditions / clauses and will not have the right to challenge any of the clauses contained in the prospectus.
